<u>Roles</u>

Role of Parents

Parents will be asked to:

- Sign a consent form to permit their children to participate in the Walking Bus
- Ensure that their child/children arrive at their 'Bus Stop' on time in the morning.
- Ensure children follow the rules set out in the Children's Behaviour Agreement form
- Ensure children are dropped off at school if they miss the Walking School Bus

Role of Children

Participating children will be required to:

- Sign a Children's Behaviour Agreement form
- Abide by the Children's Behaviour Agreement and Walking School Bus Rules
- Listen to and respect the Walking School Bus 'driver' and 'conductor'
- Arrive on time at their 'bus stop'

Role of Volunteers

Volunteers will be required to:

- Assist children to walk safely to and from school
- Undergo volunteer training
- Undergo a police check
- Follow the safety protocols outlined in this information booklet and volunteer handbook
- Liaise with the WSB School Co-ordinator and/or WSB Project Officer or Council Staff concerning program activities
- Maintain regular monitoring practices as set out in the program guidelines eg. bus attendance checklists
- Take responsibility for the safety and conduct of participating children during the operating hours of the Walking School Bus

Rules of the Walking School Bus

- Parents must sign a consent form for their children to participate.
- Students must sign a Children's Behaviour Agreement to participate.
- Children must abide by the behaviour agreement. Children who do not follow the rules will be given a warning and if misbehaviour persists they may no longer be able to participate in the program.
- The 'walking buses' must run on time and will not wait for latecomers.
- Children should be present at the 'Bus Stop' when the Walking School Bus arrives.
- Parents/Carers are responsible for their child/children until the Walking School Bus leaves their 'bus stop' in the morning.
- Dogs are not allowed on the bus.
- Eating is not allowed on the bus.
- No bikes or scooters are allowed on the bus.
